## Reminder: Public Health Emergency for COVID-19 To End

BlueCross BlueShield of South Carolina has closely monitored the status of COVID-19 to ensure our provider community remained abreast of any changes in policy or procedure related to the care of your patients, our members. On Feb. 9, 2023, the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced the public health emergency (PHE) for COVID-19 will end on **May 11, 2023**.

As COVID-19 remains a priority over the next several months, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will work to ensure a smooth transition. Throughout the PHE, CMS used a combination of emergency authority waivers, regulations, enforcement discretion and sub-regulatory guidance to ensure patients had access to care. The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023, expanded some of these flexibilities. Others are no longer needed.
